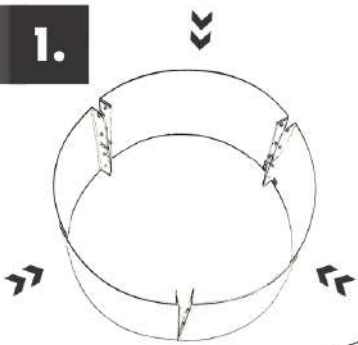

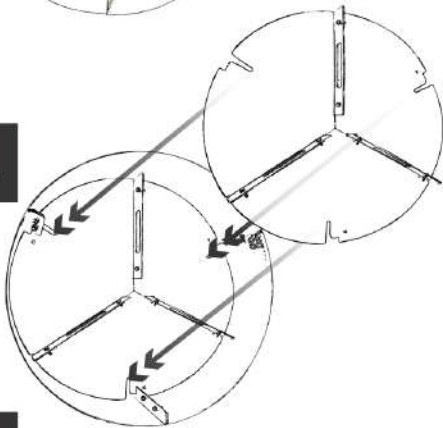

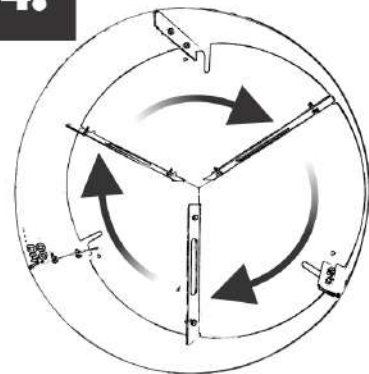

Steps 1. - 5., Maintenance & WARNINGS

1.

- 1. Assemble the OUTER Panels:** Take the curved metal panels labeled **Part A**. Arrange them in a circular formation, ensuring the inner tabs are aligned and touching each other.
- 2. Fasten the Tabs:** Use the provided spanners to secure the tabs together. Utilize the **nuts and bolts labeled B and C** for this purpose.
- 3. Adding a Grill (Optional):** If you are adding a grill to your assembly, use **bolt labeled A** for the top of the nut and bolt assembly on the curved panel tabs.

2.

- 1. Assemble the INNER Panels:** Take the metal panels labeled **Part B**. Arrange them so that the three sections form a complete circle, meeting at a central point.
- 2. Bolt the Panels Together:** Use the **nuts and bolts labeled B** to secure the three panels together. Ensure all connections are tight and secure.

3.

ENSURE THE LARGER SIDE OF THE CONE SHAPE IS FACING UPWARDS.

- 1. Combine the Assemblies:** Take the assembly from **Step 2** and position it above the assembly from **Step 1**.
- 2. Align and Slide:** Carefully slide the assembly from **Step 2** down along the fold lines of the assembly from **Step 1**. Ensure that the ridges on the assembly from **Step 2** align with the corresponding gaps in the assembly from **Step 1**.
- 3. Secure the Fit:** Once aligned, gently slide the ridges into the gaps to secure the two assemblies together.

4.

- 1. Identify the Arrows:** On the assembly from **Step 2**, locate the arrows pointing in a clockwise direction.
- 2. Prepare to Twist:** Hold the handle tabs on the assembly from **Step 2** firmly.
- 3. Twist and Lock:** Twist the assembly from **Step 2** in the direction indicated by the arrows. Continue twisting until the ridges on the assembly from **Step 2** lock securely into the folds of the assembly from **Step 1**.

5.

- 1. Invert the BOMA:** Carefully turn the BOMA upside down, so the SKBOMA logo is on the floor side.
- 2. Position for Use:** This will place the BOMA in the correct position for you to begin lighting a fire. Enjoy!

MAINTENANCE:

You have two options for maintaining your BOMA:

- 1. Rust Patina Look:** If you prefer the rustic, weathered appearance, allow the BOMA to rust naturally. Exposure to water will create a rust patina all around the BOMA.
- 2. Preventing Rust to keep Carbon Steel finish:** If you prefer to avoid the rust look, follow these steps: **Weekly Maintenance:** Clean and oil the BOMA with boiled linseed oil using a rag. **After Each Use:** After every fire, ensure the BOMA is cleaned and oiled to maintain its condition and prevent rust.
- 3. Grill Maintenance (if applicable):** If your BOMA includes a grill, wipe it down every two weeks with vegetable oil, preferably olive oil. This will prevent rust and help retain the grill's black appearance.



WARNING:

- 1. Sharp Edges:** Be aware that the BOMA components have relatively sharp edges. Assemble with care, preferably using protective gloves to avoid injury.
- 2. Rust Stains:** When the BOMA rusts, it may stain the surface it rests on, even though it stands on its three feet. To prevent rust stains, use a rust-removing solution on the surface periodically.
